
This practical guide to steel partitioning will help you to identify the type of partition you require, and the steps to help you make an enquiry for quoting.

Single Runs:

Single runs, also known as single-sided, tend to be used to create dividing walls between two existing walls. Whether this is a solid wall, wall with throughway access or partial dividing wall to separate bays or work environments. These can also be free-standing single run units.

Solid panel single run with door access




Upper glazed vision panels single run with door access


Two Runs:

Two runs, also known as two-sided, L-shape or double runs tend to be used to create corner partitions, including offices, storage areas and general enclosed areas where the two runs fix up to an existing L-shape wall. Two runs systems can also be free-standing units.

Below are some common examples of two runs:








Upper glazed panels - two runs
with door access


Three Runs:

Below are some common examples of three runs:








Upper glazed panels - three runs


Four Runs:

Four runs, also known as four sided or enclosed are free-standing partitions that tend to be used to create partitions, including offices, separated work environments, storage areas, general enclosed and clean areas where the four runs act as an independent free-standing system.



Configurations:

We offer our systems in single skin and double skin steel construction.

Single skin is our budget friendly choice where an ideal solution for a high quality and cost effective partitioning system is required for separating work or storage areas.

Double skin is an alternative higher quality partitioning system where a smooth interior finish or good sound reduction is required. Ideal for works offices, clean rooms and storage areas for chemicals and food products.

Panel Configurations:

We offer our systems with the panel choice of solid steel panel, upper or lower glazed and full glazed.

Solid Steel Panel: Best suited to create a more contained environment where aspects as higher impact resistance is required or to create a stronger shield defence from internal or external works and environments.

Upper / Lower Glazed: Allow for internal and external visibility and natural lighting where vision panel access is required.

Full Glazed: Typically used to allow maximum vision and natural lighting to the partition system, and sometimes used where display areas and full capacity vision is required.

Our partition systems can be configured to suit your specific requirements, such as full solid panels, alternated glazed panels, or fully glazed panels.

Our standard offering of glazed panels come in 6mm toughened glass panels, but we can offer other options where a higher impact resistance is required.

Access Configurations:

Our systems come with a range of access options to choose from:

- **Single & Double Side-Hung Access Doors**
- **Single & Double Sliding Doors**
- **Swing Gates**
- **PVC Curtain Strips**
